

DJ set **Martini Bros**

Biography

Since 2001, the name Martini Bros is a reference (often a source) for those Indie investigators, unhappy either with chart songs and dancing alone in their bedrooms.

The start was at maximum speed and events so many (DJ dates in bar of capacity 20 such as club of 800, radio shows, promotion, newsletters, gigs, ...) and shortly the project has been known allover Italy and in London as well, remarkable for that was a time when neither Tom himself got Myspace.

Three years after founding Martini Bros, Gian Maria Girardi started a press/promotion agency called Foreign Affairs, rising profile for international talents on the Italian territory.

Promotion campaigns been done for: Kitsuné Records, Club NME DJ's, Ciccone, 100 Bullets Back, M.A.S.S, The Boy Least Likely To, Art Brut, The Rakes, Wrath Records, Viarosa, Goldblade, Monkey Island, ...

At the dawn of 2006 as he return home from some London dates, he launches a new club night in Italy called Excuse Me, where the music is disco/rock clash, built on all of that electro influenced rock and also all of that guitar influenced electro.

Points of interest

- Some dates in Italy: sPAZIO211 Torino, Arteria Bologna, ZO Catania, Vibra Modena, Mattatoio Carpi, etc. International: Razzmatazz Barcelona, Club NME @KOKO London, Yoga Bala Athens, Art House Salonicco, Atomic Cafè Munich, LOW Madrid, White Heat @Madame JoJos, Casino Royale @Barfly, 93 Feet East, Blow Up @Metro, 333, ...)
- An average of 60 DJ sets/Year;
- Martini Bros is in touch with more than 1,000 bands and 800 labels worldwide (90% British) which also get a newsletter with updates and playlists.
- DJ sets with live shows: Infadels, The Kills, Infadels, The Pipettes, The Raveonettes, Kaiser Chiefs, Bloc Party, Peter Hook (come DJ), Graham Coxon, Electric Six, Art Brut, TV Personalities, Liars, the Datsuns, Turin Brakes, Interpol, Black Heart Procession, Oneida, British Sea Power, Cousteau/Moreau, the Veils, Delays, Blurt, 90 Day Men and Italians such as Yuppie Flu, Baustelle, Giardini di Mirò e Three Second Kiss;
- French Disco is the name of one specific DJ set with just French songs, mainly from the past;
- Myspace: about 14000 friends for Martini Bros and 15000 for Excuse Me
